On 25 April, a terrible earthquake hit Nepal. More than 8,000 people died and many more were injured. The earthquake destroyed homes, schools and hospitals. It also affected the water supply. People in some areas didn't have enough clean water to drink. A group of volunteers from the UK went to Nepal to help. They took medicines and medical supplies. They also took food, water and tents for people who had lost their homes. The conditions were very difficult. There was no running water and it was very hot during the day and very cold at night. The volunteers worked long hours and often didn't have enough to eat or drink. They didn't have time to rest or sleep. Many of them were ill but they didn't stop working. They helped to clear the rubble and they looked for survivors. They worked with the Nepalese rescue teams. The Nepalese people were very grateful for their help. The volunteers said it was an awful experience but it was also very rewarding. They said they learnt a lot and that it was a big challenge but they would do it again.
