



What's the Difference Between Weather and Climate?





 weather — conditions
climate — how the of the atmosphere over a short period of time

atmosphere "behaves" over relatively long periods of time

Main types of climate

- There are approximately five main climate types on Earth:
- TROPICAL
- DRY
- TEMPERATE
- CONTINENTAL
- POLAR

Tropical climate


In this hot and humid (wet) zone, the average temperatures are greater than 25°C year-round and there is usually a lot of rain



Dry climate

These climate zones are so dry because moisture (little drops of water) is quickly evaporated* from the air and there is very little

rain

Temperate climate

In this zone, there are typically warm and wet summers with thunderstorms and mild winters



Continental climate

These regions have warm or cool summers and very cold winters. In the winter, in this zone there can be snowstorms, strong winds, and very cold temperatures—sometimes below -

30°C!



Polar climate

In the polar climate zones, it's extremely cold. Even in summer, the temperatures here never go higher than 10°C!
