

Грамматическая контрольная работа по английскому языку Бигуловой З.К. по теме «Настоящее простое/Настоящее продолженное время» и «Модальные глаголы can/could, must/have to, should/ought to» к УМК К.М. Барановой, Д.Дули «Звездный английский» 6 класс.

Грамматическая контрольная работа составлена по грамматическому материалу Модуля 1. Работа состоит из двух заданий. В первом задании учащимся предлагается 10 предложений на раскрытие скобок в настоящем простом и настоящем продолженном времени. Во втором задании учащимся предлагается 10 предложений с выбором правильного модального глагола.

Вся работа основана на пройденном материале, который отрабатывался на протяжении всей четверти.

Работа содержит два варианта.

Variant I
