Актуальность проекта

Описание проекта

В рамках данного проекта, школьники собирают и оформляют стенд, состоящий из фотографий своих прадедов — ветеранов. Ребята инициируют интересные исследования, чтобы узнать о биографии своих предков, их военных подвигах, наградах и личных историях.

На стенде будет представлена информация о каждом ветеране, включая фото, краткие биографии, а также описания их заслуг и наград. 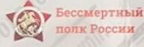

Dzabolov Magomed Dnsovich was born in 1905 in the Ossetian ASSR (now the Republic of North Ossetia-Alania). He joined the Red Army in 1921.

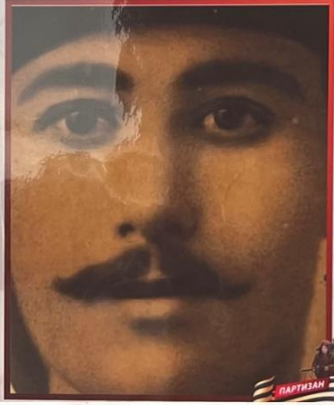
Buzaladze Ivan Mikhailovich was born in 1911 in the Georgian SSR. In 1931, he was drafted into the war and served in the 359th Mountain Rifle.



Akhanov Akim Kazbekovich was a historian and made a significant contribution to the study of the history of Ossetia and the North Caucasus.
 He was born in the village of Syrdzysar in 1903. He studied at the Ossetian Pedagogical College, then received higher education in Kyrgyz and Moscow.
 Akim Kazbekovich worked in scientific institutes in Moscow, Ossetia, and then in Kyrgyzstan, specializing in "History of the Peoples of the North Caucasus".
 He also was a member of the CPSU since 1938.
 From June 1941 to April 1942 he was on the Western Front. In April 1943 he was seriously wounded and retired into the reserve due to disability.
 After the war, working at the history department of SOGDI, he took an active part in writing the "History of the North Ossetian ASSR", "Revolution of 1905-1907 in the Terek" etc.
 Akim Kazbekovich was awarded the Order of the Red Star, the Order of the Patriotic War, I degree, and 14 medals.



Бессмертный полк России



My great-grandfather Aylarov Khazbi Khodzazovich was in the ranks of the partisans during the Great Patriotic War. He was very brave and courageous and a very accurate shooter.
 The partisan movement played an important role in resisting the German occupiers. Partisan detachments began operating on November 10, 1942, striking at the enemy in the rear.
 On December 8, 1942, the partisan detachment where my great-grandfather fought attacked the Nazis in the Khutlak area. As a result, 28 were killed and 20 wounded, two fascists were captured, the Khutlak timber mill was disabled, a heavy machine gun with a crew was destroyed, and telephone communications were disrupted.
 I remember and am proud of my great-grandfather!

Afanasy Davydovich Dauv – participant of the Great Patriotic War, lieutenant colonel.

He was born on March 5, 1912 in the North Ossetian ASSR, in the village of Darg-Kokhi.

He entered the service on May 25, 1938, the date of completion of service – February 28, 1954.

Among the awards Dauv Afanasy Davydovich: medal «For victory over Germany in the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945», the medal «For the defense of Stalingrad», the medal «For the capture of Königsberg».

Dauv A.D., working as a senior operative commissioner of the Regional Office of the NKVD, took part in battles with the German occupants from the beginning of the Patriotic War. Being at work in OO NKVD 208 SD, he personally exposed and arrested 27 persons of K-R (counter-revolutionary) and anti-Soviet element, including 2 German spies, revealed and prevented a group of traitors to the Motherland, one member of the national K-R organization and other various anti-Soviet element. Defended the approaches to the city of Stalingrad from German invaders. On August 6 (the year is illegible), performing an operational Checkist task, Comrade Dauv was in the 2nd Battalion, 760 SP, 208 SD, at the moment when the German occupiers broke through our defense line.

Heroes of the Great Patriotic War

They were people who readily gave their lives for bright and cloudless future of their motherland and the life of their descendents.



Tavitov Danel Takaevich

On June 22, 1941, the Nazis attacked our Motherland. Almost from the first days, my great-grandfather entered into battle with the Nazi invaders. Participated in the Battle for Moscow

I want to talk about my great-grandfather. His name was Danel. He was born in a mountain village, which was called the village of the Tavitovs. When he was 18 years old, he joined the Red Army.

Having blown up on a mine he was captured by the enemy. Having organized an escape from captivity, he brought about 100 people to his own. He continued the war as part of a horse-mechanized brigade under the command of Issa Alexandrovich Pliev. My great-grandfather participated in the liberation of Czechoslovakia.

For the Victory, having visited relatives, he went



Ramazan Avshimaikhovich Elov was born in 1928 in the village of Lesken in the Irafsky district. At the age of 14, in 1942, he joined a partisan detachment, where he served until the end of the war. He graduated from high school in 1948. In 1951, he began his career as a school teacher in Dushanbe, where he later became director. In 1979, as a reserve officer, he was drafted into the Armed Forces of the USSR. He served until March 1982.
