Anthropologists formulated a theory of cultural evolution in which they divided human development into three stages: savagery, barbarism and civilization.

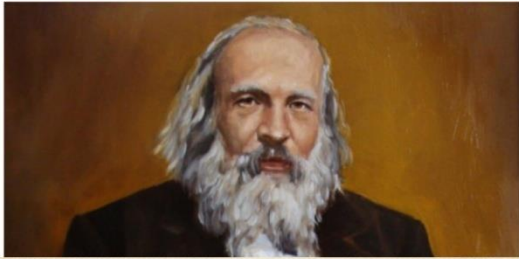
б) главные изобретения человечества

The survey showed that there isn't any single leader among students. They called different people from Jesus Christ and Moses to Elon Musk and Steve Jobs.



General Facts

Isaac Newton (1643-1727) - English physicist and mathematician, who created the theoretical foundations of mechanics and astronomy, discovered the law of universal gravitation, developed (along with G. Leibniz) differential and integral calculus, the inventor of the mirror telescope and the author of the most important experimental works on optics. Isaac Newton, the son of a small but well-to-do farmer, was born in the village of Woolsthorpe (Lincolnshire). Newton's father did not live to see his son born. In January 1646, Newton's mother remarried.



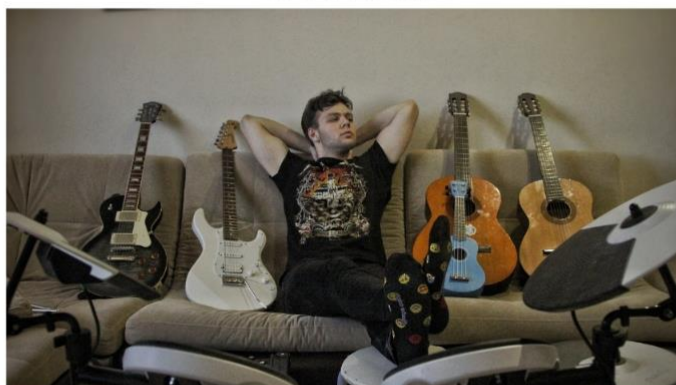
Zarina Kazbekovna
